- The Inspection of aircraft structures in accordance with Service Bulletins, AD's and aircraft manuals, to Inspection and assessment of corrosion and damage to aircraft structures.
- The design and layout of a structural repair manual (SRM) repair with minimal assistance
- Construction and set up of jigs and fixtures
- Source appropriate calibrated tooling for the jobs

Complete all general repairs, such as;

- Sealant of metal and composite surfaces
- Installation of fasteners
- Treatment of metals and corrosion
- Assembly and fitting of parts
- Repair, replace, and modify metal alloy and composite structures
- Fabrication of sheet metal parts
- Ability to source and use correct composite materials for bonding a fastener or simple repair
- Understanding of aircraft fastener codes and uses/installations
